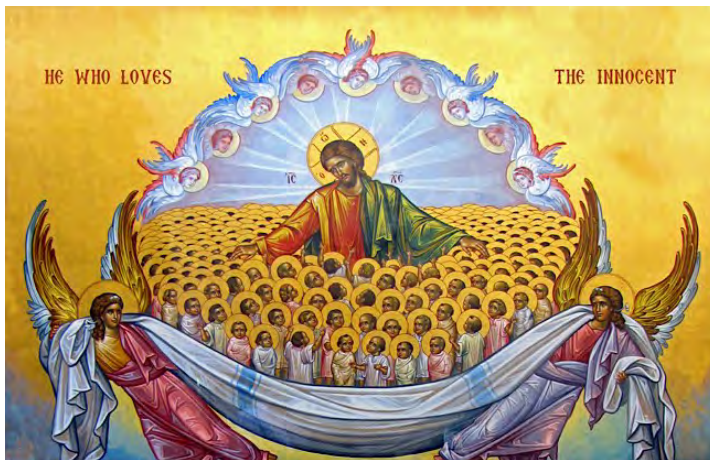

Abortion in America

"America you are beautiful and blessed. The ultimate test of your greatness is the way you treat every human being, but especially the weakest and most defenseless. If you want equal justice for all and true freedom and lasting peace, then America, defend life". - Pope John Paul II

- America was founded upon the "self-evident truth" that all humans are endowed with the unalienable right to LIFE. Yet a baby is aborted every 23 seconds in the U.S. Over 4,000 babies are aborted every day. About 60 million babies have been aborted since the decision of Roe v Wade in January 1973. Abortion is truly "America's holocaust".

- As a result of Roe v Wade and sister case, Doe v Bolton, America has some of the most liberal laws on abortion in the world, effectively allowing abortion on demand throughout the whole nine months of pregnancy.

- The abortion rate in the U.S. is higher than Western Europe and Canada. It is not as high as the rates in China, Cuba and the former Soviet Union countries which have reached epidemic levels.

- Teenagers constitute around 20% of all abortions in the U.S. About 55% of minors who have abortions do not tell their parents.

- 17 states use public funds to pay for abortions, so about 15% of all abortions in the U.S. are paid for with public money. Our tax dollars fund Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest abortion provider and promoter of casual sex and abortion

What are the significant roles of the angels in the New Testament?

Angels are active throughout the New Testament as special messengers of God.

1. The Archangel Gabriel revealed to Zacharias the forthcoming birth of St. John the Baptist. (Lk 1:11-20)
2. The Archangel Gabriel assured St. Joseph of St. Mary's purity. He warned him of Herod's plot and told him about Herod's death. (Mt 1:20-25, 2:12, 2:19-20)
3. The angels announced Jesus' birth to the shepherds. (Lk 2:8-15)
4. The angels ministered to Jesus during His temptation (Mt 4:11), when He was in the Garden of Gethsemane (Lk 22:43), and during the resurrection (Mt 28:2-6).
4. The angels helped the Apostles in their ministry. (Acts 1:10-11, 5:17-20)
5. The angels sent Philip into the desert to meet the eunuch. (Acts 8:26)
6. An angel instructed Cornelius to send for St. Peter. (Acts 10:3-8)
7. An angel released St. Peter from prison. (Acts 12:7)
8. An angel judged Herod because of his blasphemy. (Act 12:23)
9. An angel reassured St. Paul in a storm at the sea. (Acts 27:23-24)
