8/24 Wednesday

St. Euthyches, Bishop-Martyr, disciple of John the Theologian, Apostle and Evangelist.

8/25 Thursday

Return of the Relics of Bartholomew, Apostle. **St. Titus**, Apostle. Titus was the favoured disciple of St. Paul and was his successor as the first Bishop of the island of Crete. He died full of merits about the close of the first century.

8/26 Friday

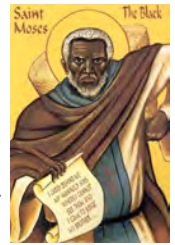
SS. Adrian and Natalia, Martyrs, endured death A.D. 304, during the reign of Maximian, Emperor.

8/27 Saturday

Our Venerable Father, Poemen, an Egyptian by birth, flourished in the period of the Ecumenical Council at Ephesus A.D. 431, in the reign of Theodosius the Younger, Emperor.

8/28 Sunday
