EASTER BAKE SALE REPORT we have a profit of \$6,924.98. Thanks to the dedicated work of our parishioners and to the wonderful customers that appreciate the love and care we put into our baked goods. Thank you.

LEAKING TILE ROOF ON HALL Repair \$12,000. not covered by Insurance—due to lack of maintenance on Tiles. Tile roofs require a yearly inspection. Damages to classrooms & parish hall from recent heavy rains. Plaster and repainting the rooms and hall: \$13,000. refused by Insurance. Father Stephen spoke with Alton's Insurance and they will review and give a final notice this week as to whether the Insurance will cover some of the damages. We have a \$2,500 deductible.

BROKEN IRRIGATION LINE BREAKS & FLOODS RECTORY LIVING ROOM The carpeting was floating on the water. The line which feeds the sprinklers in the back yard and pool which is located on the north side of the rectory behind the fireplace. *The cost: \$1,900 to repair the line.* We were able to save the carpeting and the water did not reach the plastered walls. Thanks to the great response of Stephen and Bob.

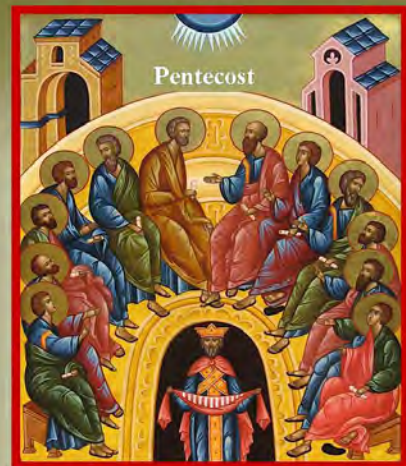
