**20th Sunday After Pentecost**

**Miracles of raising the dead**

There are some precedents for this extraordinary miracle. Two prophets perform this type of miracle. In 1Kings 17:17-24 Elijah raises the son of a poor widow. His apprentice Elisha performs a very similar miracle for a woman from Shunem 2 Kings 4:18-37. In these stories the prophet carries out certain actions such as laying on the child, shutting himself within the room.

In the Gospel, Jesus raises the son of a widow from Naim Luke 7:11-17 and the daughter of Jairus Mk 5:21-43. Note these are all children who have died and they have not yet been buried. Jesus comes to them soon after the event of the death since Jewish burial takes place on the same day.

The Lazarus miracle is much more dramatic. Lazarus is an adult. He is dead for four days. According to Jewish belief, the soul of a person was thought to hover around the body for a short time after death. But once the body begins to corrupt and the features change, usually by the fourth day, that is a sign that the soul has now departed, and corruption is irreversible.
