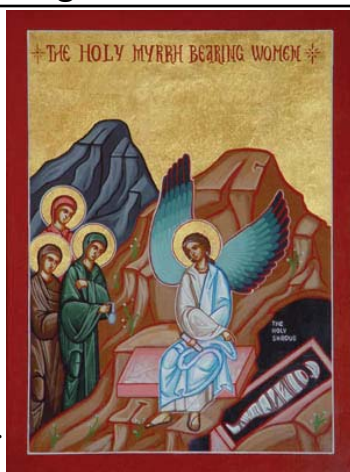

Christ is Risen! Indeed He is Risen!

Most Rev. Bishops and Priests,

Sunday May 12, 2019 is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations.

“The purpose of the **World Day of Prayer for Vocations** is to publically fulfill the Lord’s instruction to, “Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest” (Mt 9:38; Lk10:2). As a climax to a prayer that is continually offered throughout the Church, it affirms the primacy of faith and grace in all that concerns vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life. While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the *ordained ministries (priesthood and diaconate, to the Religious life in all its forms (male and female, contemplative and apostolic), to societies of apostolic life, to secular institutes in their diversity of services and membership, and to the missionary life, in the particular sense of mission “ad gentes”.*’

2019 marks the **56th Anniversary** of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations
