This commitment is made concrete through the affirmation and recognition of all those who are directly responsible for carrying out the religious education programs and activities of the parish. This day also presents an opportunity for all the faithful to look at what they have been given and think of ways for them to contribute to the essential teaching mission of the Church.

Jesus loved to bless and welcome the children of the villages He visited when He was in Palestine. He told us we had to become like you in order to be part of His kingdom.
