#### LEGEND OF THE RED EGG



According to the ancient tradition of the East Mary Magdalene was a wealthy woman from whom Christ expelled seven demons. During the three years of Jesus' ministry she helped support him and his other disciples from her means. When almost everyone else fled, she stayed with him at the cross. On Easter morning she was the first to bear witness to his Resurrection. She is called "Equal

to the Apostles."

The Eastern tradition tells us that after the Ascension, she journeyed to Rome where she was admitted to the court of Tiberius Caesar because of her high social standing. After describing how poorly Pilate had administered justice at Jesus' trail, she told Caesar that Jesus had risen from the dead. To help explain his Resurrection she picked up an egg from the dinner table. Caesar responded that a human being could no longer rise for the dead than the egg in her hand turn red. The egg turned red immediately, which is why red eggs have been exchanged at Easter for centuries in the Byzantine East.

Mary traveled the Mediterranean preaching the Resurrection. Like Peter and Paul, she died a martyr. She bears witness to the important role women once help in the Church.

#### The Blessing of the Artos

The Artos is a round loaf of bread with an icon depicting the Resurrection of Christ placed upon it. On Easter morning it replaces the cross and icon on the tetrapod. It symbolizes the Risen Christ, who has become for us the "Bread of Life" and the "New Passover" by His glorious victory over death. The Artos is blessed during the Divine Liturgy of Easter Morning, after the prayer before the ambon.

Priest: Let us pray to the Lord.

People: Lord, have mercy.

Priest: Almighty God and Lord of the universe, You willed that your servant Moses, after the exodus of Israel from Egypt, freeing your people from, the bitter slavery of Pharaoh, to slay a lamb, that foreshadowed the Lamb slain on the cross for us; freely taking upon himself the sins of the whole world - your beloved son, our Lord Jesus Christ. We

humbly implore you today, look down also upon this bread; bless + and sanctify it, as we, your servants, offer it to the honor and glory, and in remembrance, of the glorious Resurrection of your Son and our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have been freed from the eternal slavery of the enemy and the unbreakable bonds of hell, and have received freedom and salvation; we offer it now, standing before your majesty on this radiant, glorious, and saving day of the Resurrection. Allow us, who offer this bread, who kiss it and partake of it, to become partakers of your heavenly bless. By your power free us from all pain and sickness, granting health to us all, for you are the source of all blessings and healing, and we give glory to you, eternal Father, one with your only-begotten Son and your holy, good and life- giving Spirit, now and always and forever.

People: Amen.

(The priest sprinkles the Artos with holy water)
This Artos is blessed and made holy by the power and action of the Holy Spirit in the sprinkling of this holy water, in the name of the Father and of the Holy Spirit.

People: Amen.
