Dear Father Stephen,

With our 2020 Eparchial Appeal now completed, I wish to offer my gratitude to you and your parishioners for their most generous contributions which, as in past years, have helped to make this year's Appeal most successful. In a year that has seen great challenges, locally, nationally, and around the world, particularly as a result of the corona virus pandemic, your parish's concern for the needs of our Eparchy, expressed in your donations to the Appeal, has been truly exemplary. This is of great assistance in continuing the good work of the Gospel in our Eparchy in the many ways in which that mission is accomplished, as was detailed in this year's Appeal brochure.

This vital work is also supported, as in past years, through the issuance of rebate checks directly to parishes which have met or exceeded their goals. Additionally, due to the negative economic impact which many have experienced in this remarkable year, the decision has been made to make base 10% rebates, for this particular year, to all parishes, regardless of the total donated. To those parishes which have achieved or surpassed their goals, the rebate consists of 10% of the parish goal amount, and 100% of any amount which has exceeded its goal. Therefore, I am most pleased to include, with this letter, your parish rebate check for the 2020 Eparchial Appeal, in the amount of \$1,942.00, which has been calculated as follows:

Amount Contributed Over Goal:	<u>\$0.00</u>
Total Rebate:	<u>\$1,942.00</u>

A copy of the final report for the 2020 Eparchial Appeal, dated 30 October 2020 is also enclosed for your records, along with an individual donor listing on which it is based.

As in prior years, your parish rebate **is not** subject to the cathedraticum tax, and it may be used, in its entirety, for any parish project or need, as an unrestricted gift.

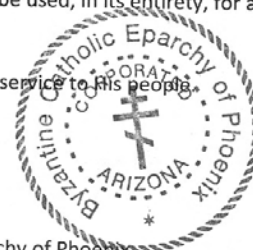
Thank you, so much, and may God bless you, and continue to guide you in your priestly service to His people.
