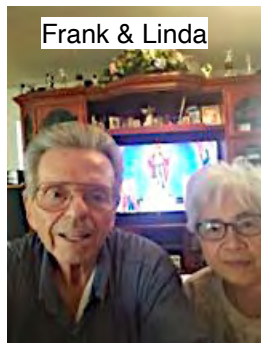

Policy Statement on the Eparchial Directives Regarding Parish Liturgical and Other Activities Relevant to the Corona Virus Pandemic

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Annunciation and St. Nicholas of Myra,

I am to inform you of the Eparchial guidelines put forth by Bishop Olmstead as well as to publish the guidelines we are putting forth here at Annunciation and at St. Nicholas of Myra Parish in Fontana in accord with the Eparchial Policy Statement and the current California Guidance.

- 1) The Sunday & Holy Day Obligation remains dispensed until May 31st, 2020;
- 2) The faithful are encouraged to wear mask, gloves, or other personal protective equipment (PPE);
- 3) Confessions are heard outside in the garden under the umbrella north side of the church half hour before all Holy Services or after the Services. You may call for an appointment.
- 4) Individuals or households must remain at least 6ft from one another. Use the blue tape markers on the ground while lining up to receive communion outside in front of the church. For those visiting the church every other pew is Blue Taped Off to help with 6 foot social distancing. The few chairs in the chapel are spaced out for social distancing.
- 5) Communion will continue to be distributed by means of the spoon. The faithful are to be sure to stand up straight, tilt their head back and open their mouth wide so that the clergy may drop the Precious Body and Blood of our Lord into your mouth without contact with the Sacred Vessels, the Paten or Communion Cloth.
- 6) Individuals who are high-risk (65 and over/underlying health conditions) are strongly encouraged not to attend services in person; they and other faithful who do not attend are still encouraged to use the streaming service available on [facebook.com/stephen.washko](https://www.facebook.com/stephen.washko) or [@Annunciation.byzantine](https://www.facebook.com/Annunciation.byzantine); For St Nicholas of Myra Facebook [@saintnicholasfontanaca](https://www.facebook.com/saintnicholasfontanaca)
- 7) If you or someone in your family is ill, please attend the liturgical celebrations via streaming; All parish activities outside of liturgical celebrations remain suspended until at least May 31, 2020;
- 8) Page numbers from the Green Pew Book are given in the parish bulletin for you to follow during the live streaming.
- 9) You may use the Black Secured Mail Box located next to the doors of the church to deposit your Tithing Envelope. At St. Nicholas in Fontana use the Black Secured Mail Box located on Oleander Street or the collection box located at the side entrance of the church.
- 10) Church open during the week from 8am till 5pm for personal prayer with the exception of Tuesdays & Thursdays. For St Nicholas call before coming to church.

For your information, both the Eparchial Policy Statement and California Guidance are posted on your email and on the doors of the church. As always, feel free to contact me personally should you have any questions or concerns. I look forward to seeing and praying with you soon! May God be with you during this challenging time.
