Dear Clergy and Faithful of Holy Protection of Mary Byzantine Catholic Eparchy of Phoenix,

Having journeyed through the Great Fast (Lent) and Holy Week, we will arrive at our Lord's great and glorious super Sunday of the Resurrection and we will joyously proclaim:

Christ is Risen!

Easter, Pascha, is the greatest feast day for us. In the Easter Matins it is described as the "chosen and holy day feast of feasts most solemn day". We rejoice and celebrate what our Lord has done and what He continues to do for us in His Resurrection from the dead. The feast of Easter, the Pascha of the Lord, even in this time of the pandemic, is the day of Adam and Eve's liberation and of all humanity from the bondage of sin and death. Wishing you and your family a joyous celebration of the GREAT DAY that the Lord has made.
