With profound joy and gratitude to Almighty God, I share with you the blessed news that our missionary Eparchy has received a new priest: **Father Forrest Tucker**, who was ordained to the Holy Priesthood on Pentecost Sunday May 24, 2026, in Spokane, Washington.

In a very beautiful and providential way, this priestly vocation was nurtured and brought to birth in the spiritual womb of Saints Cyril and Methodius Byzantine Catholic Parish, a community named for the great missionary brothers who carried the light of Christ to the Slavic peoples. The ordination itself took place at Saint Mary Roman Catholic Church, reminding us once again of the beautiful communion and friendship between East and West in the one Body of Christ.
